#### Autumn Is A Prime Time To Tend Lawns And Gardens

Autumn is gardening season. That statement may not seem right to those who think of the spring as the peak time to care for lawns and gardens. However, autumn is an ideal time to get into the garden and ensure that flowers, trees and garden beds will over-winter successfully.

A number of things make autumn a prime gardening season. The cooler days of fall enable gardeners to spend ample time outdoors without the threat of blazing heat. In addition, soil harbors a lot of residual warmth in autumn. Also, the colder temperatures haven't yet arrived in autumn, nor have the leaves completely fallen, making fall a prime time to assess what's already in the landscape, what needs pruning back and where to address planting for next year

Gardening enthusiasts can focus their attention on these areas this fall.

- PAMPER PERENNIALS. As annuals and perennials start to fall back, mark the spots where perennials are located so they can be easily identified later on. This way, when planning spots for spring bulbs or other spring layouts for next year, perennials won't be overlooked or cov-
- ered over.
   PRUNE SHRUBS. Look at shrubs and trees and cut out dead or diseased wood.
- CLEAN UP BORDERS. Weed and tidy up borders and lawn edging.
  • INSTALL PAVERS OR ROCK
- WALL Embrace the cooler temperatures to work on laborintensive projects, such as putting in a garden bed, retain-
- ing wall or walkway.

  REMOVE SPENT SUMMER VEGGIES. Take out vegetable garden plants that have already bloomed and borne fruit. Tidy up vegetable gardens and start to sow cooler weather plants, such as onions, garlic, beans, and sweet peas.
- RAKE AND COMPOST. Rake the leaves and gather grass clippings to add to the compost

#### It's Good To Be Prepared For Bad Weather

(NAPS)- The hurricane season in the United States runs from June 1 through November 30, though the storms have been known to occur at other times. For 2018, experts at Colorado State University believe, the country can expect an above average storm season, with 14 named storms and seven hurricanes, three of them major. Regardless of whether these weather predictions come true, it's always a good idea for home and business owners to take the necessary steps ahead of the storm warnings and the inevitable rush for emergency supplies.

#### WHAT TO DO

Home and business owners can take a simple but proactive course of action. For example, preparations should start earlier than the issued hurricane warnings.

1. Getting a generator can be a good idea. They keep critical appliances running. Lights stay on, devices charged and weather updates are available on television, radio or online. Most tropical storms cause a disruption in electricity. Depending on the storm's intensity, damage to the electrical infrastructure can be extensive. Downed power lines, flooding, fallen structures, debris and other obstacles will affect the speed of power restoration, so it's important to prepare for an outage duration that become uncomfort-

A portable generator should be exercised every month. Schedule maintenance if needed. When you get a portable generator, use a sizing calculator to gauge your needs. Additionally, homeowners who seek greater peace of mind from an automatic home standby generator should schedule an in-home assessment, as automatic home standby units take time to get installed. "It's better to be ready for

a nonevent than it is to be caught off guard by a strong storm," explained Russ storm," explained Russ Minick, chief marketing offi-cer at Generac Power Systems. "We believe we can offer manageable ways to guide home owners and businesses through the storm season, but staying safe starts with prepared-

An emergency hurricane kit for the family and any pets should be easily accessible within the home. In addition to food and bottled water, the kit should include a flashlight, first aid kit, battery-powered radio, a whistle to signal for help, and an assortment of hand tools. If someone in the home is dependent on elecfor life-sustaining medical equipment, review the family plan to access backup power or make arrangements to relocate when storm warnings are issued.

3. Outages and the need for fuel go hand in hand. During a power outage, you still might need to be out and about—maybe even evacuate the area—so ensuring that your car is fueled is important. In a worst-case scenario, your car can serve as a source of light, heat and electricity. A portable generator is far better suited to provide backup power, though, so make sure it has clean fuel, as well. And make sure any fuel you store is kept in approved containers. Learn More



Rather than having to bend down to seek out that favorite flavor of Greek yogurt, choose a model with the fridge on top and freezer on the bottom, especially if anyone in household has mobility issues. When shopping for refrigerators, Frenchdoor style units may offer even more access, making it easy for homeown-

ers to slide fruit trays, sheet cakes and other large items into the fridge. EXTRA LIGHTING: A kitchen should be a balance of form and function. A combination of overhead lighting, decorative lighting and task lighting can illuminate all areas of the space effectively

APPLIANCE GARAGES: Architectural and design resource Houzz says that appliance garages are popular kitchen additions, too. Set at countertop level, these cabinets allow people to keep small appliances plugged in but tucked neatly behind closed doors.





Though they are often easy to overlook, driveways are durable parts of a home that can greatly impact a home's curb appeal. Driveway installation costs are influenced by a host of factors, including the size of the driveway and the material it's made of. 3. CRACKS: Cracking is one of the more noticeable issues that can plague driveways. Many driveways experience cracking as materials inevitably succumb to the elements. Driveway cracks may develop for various reasons, including poor initial beneath the driveway surface may also contribute to cracking as the driveways ultimately succumb to the pressure created by the growing roots. Consider a professional home inspection. The goal is to help identify any potential hazards within your home. These can take many forms. Think knob-and-tube wiring, overloaded panels or cracked foundations

Lead paint. Older houses (pre-1978) may have base coats of lead paint beneath the newer ones. Lead can cause harmful effects if ingested or inhaled as dust. Be careful to avoid raising dust if scraping or sanding old walls or molding. Test for (and seal) exposed areas of lead paint

Educate yourself about air quality. Radón is a particular concern. It's a radioactive gas that naturally accumulates some houses—and the second leading cause of lung cancer after smoking. Use a radon longterm detector to measure the level of radon in your home to determine if you need to reduce

Pay close attention to combustion appliances. If not properly maintained or vented to the outside, combustion appliances including your furnace, gas stove or water heater, can release pollutants such as carbon monoxide-a colorless and odorless gas. Ensure appliances are well maintained and inspected at least once a year. Install carbon monoxide detectors.

There's no place like home, so doing all that you can to ensure that it's a safe, healthy and comfortable place will give you the peace of mind necessary

to enjoy it to its fullest.
