



CEYLON CHICKEN CURRY & RICE NOODLE SOUP

- 6 oz. uncooked wide rice noodles 3 Tbsp. ghee or olive oil, divided
- 1 lb. boneless chicken breasts, thinly sliced and cut into
- 1/2-in. pieces 1 medium onion, chopped 2/3 cup sliced fresh carrots
- 3 bay leaves 2 Tbsp. minced fresh gingerroot
- 1 stalk lemongrass 1 whole star anise
- 1 Tbsp. curry powder
- 2 tsp. ground turmeric
- 1 garlic clove, minced 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/4 tsp. cayenne pepper 2 anchovy fillets, minced, optional
- 2 Tbsp. white wine vinegar 1 carton (32 oz.) chicken broth
- 1 can (13.66 oz. coconut milk
- 2 Tbsp. jaggery or dark brown sugar
- 1-1/2 cups chopped fresh kale
- 1/2 cup cherry tomatoes, halved

Cook the noodles according to package directions for al dente. In a Dutch oven, heat 1 Tbsp. ghee over medium-high heat. Add the chicken; cook and stir until no longer pink, 4-5 minutes. Remove

Cook and stir the onion and carrots in remaining 2 Tbsp. ghee until tender, 12-15 minutes. Add the bay leaves, ginger, lemongrass, star anise, curry powder, turmeric, garlic, salt, cayenne pepper and, if desired, anchovies; cook 1 minute longer.

Add vinegar to the pan; cook for 30 seconds, stirring to loosen browned bits from pan. Add broth, coconut milk and jaggery. Bring to a boil; reduce heat. Add kale and tomatoes; simmer until tender,

Remove and discard bay leaves, lemongrass and star anise. Drain noodles; stir into soup. Add chicken; heat through.







5 Ways To Make Homes Safer

Injuries that occur around the home contribute to millions of medical visits and tens of thousands of fatalities each year. Falls account for the largest percentage of home accidents, with the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reporting that around 30,000 fall-related fatalities occur each year in the United States. Many home accidents are entirely preventable when proper caution is exercised.

As homeowners prepare for home-improvement projects, improving safety inside and outside the home should be a priority

1. IMPROVE LIGHTING - One of the easiest ways to reduce the risk of falls is to improve light-ing around the home. The National Institutes of Health state that adequate lighting is important at entrances to the home, stairways, hallways, and other frequently traversed areas. Make sure lighting fixtures are using the highest wattage light bulb allowed. Artificial lighting sources become even more vital in fall and autumn, when natural light is less abundant in a home. In addition. install lighting outdoors by the front door, over the garage and where garbage pails are stored to

facilitate safe passage.
2. ELIMINATE SLICK SURFACES - Improving traction around the house also can minimize falls. Throw rugs and runners can be made more secure with nonslip rubber backings. Bath rugs can reduce slipping on wet surfaces in the bathroom. Also, nonslip mats can be used inside of showers and bathtubs.

Use shoe trays to reduce puddling from melting snow or rain runoff in entryways. Mop up spills quickly, and consider the use of matte- or textured-finished flooring to improve stability under-

Promptly remove snow and ice from driveways and walkways. For those who live in cold climates, heated concrete can help melt precipitation before it accumulates.

MAKE NEEDED REPAIRS - Repair loose floorboards and pull carpet taut if it has started to stretch out. Address cracks outdoors and ensure that patio stones, bricks and pavers are secure and level to reduce tripping hazards. Fix areas of the landscape where water may pool and freeze, creating potential hazards.

4. DECLUTTER ALL SPACES - Remove unnecessary items and furniture from rooms to free up more space to get around. Be sure there are no obstructions in walkways, entryways and near

doors. Keep staircases clear at all times. 5. INVEST IN ASSISTIVE DEVICES - Handrails, grab bars, nonslip stair treads, and many other devices can make homes safer for people of all ages and abilities. Outfit cabinets and closets with organizers that put frequently used items within easy reach. A sturdy step stool can reduce the risk of injury while reaching for items stored on high shelves.

Taking measures to reduce the risk of falling around the home is a worthwhile home improvement project.

Make Homes Safer For Pets

Pets require certain comforts to live long and healthy lives. In addition to adequate nutrition, exercise, medical care, and mental stimulation, pets need a safe place to live.

The average home is filled with various items that can be harmful to pets. Just as parents baby-proof their homes when welcoming new children into their families, pet owners can take inventory of potential hazards to pets and take steps to safeguard their pets from home-related injuries. According to the American Veterinary Medical Association, a few simple adjustments around the house can prevent many pet emergencies.

- Invest in cabinet locks. Cats and dogs can be curious animals, gaining access to areas of a home pet owners never would have imagined possible. If you can't store everything beyond pets' reach, then use cabinet and drawer latches to prevent access to areas that are off limits. Lock doors to basements, garages and storage sheds as well.
- Cover all garbage cans. Animals have extraordinary senses of smell, and they may be attracted to trash cans around the house. Safe Ways To Deal With Sinus Pressure

Sinuses are bony, hollow, air-filled cavities inside the face and skull. They are located in the lowcenter of the forehead, behind the eyes and in bones behind the nose. Cedars-Sinai Medical Center says the sinuses lighten the skull and produce a mucus that moisturizes the inside of the nose. Unfortunately, when colds or the flu strike, sinuses may become one of the first spots affect-

ed by these illnesses.

When the sinuses are working properly, mucus will drain into the nasal passages or out the back of the throat. Most of this drainage goes unnoticed. However, the American Sinus Institute says that factors such as allergies, illness, weather changes, dehydration, and dry air can make the sinus mucus thicker and drainage more difficult. This is when problems like infection, stuffiness or

throat irritation may occur. In order to combat sinus congestion and drainage concerns, people may try certain strategies that include flushing the sinuses and thinning the mucus. It is imperative to use safe flushing methods to keep the sinuses healthy.

Neti pots are among the more popular methods to flushing sinuses. These small teapot-like devices with elongated snouts have become a fixture in many medicine cabinets. Because they are drug-free alternatives, they can be handy for those worreacting with other drugs. Neti pots and other nasal irrigation systems use saline to moisten and clear out nasal passages to promote drainage of sinus cavities.

The key to preventing infection is to only use previously boiled, sterile or distilled water to irrigate. Tap water is not adequately filtered, says the FDA, and may contain low levels of organisms that can stay alive in nasal passages and potentially cause serious infections.

Those who are concerned about nasal irrigation safety may be wise to skip neti pots and use pre-packaged, sterile saline solutions that are bottled for the purpose of alleviating congestion.

However, when pre-pared water is used in a clean neti pot or other device, these methods can be perthese fectly safe.

Sinuses can get clogged for many rea-To free breathing, people are urged to consult their physicians to learn more about how to safely irrigate their

healthy lifestyle. While these components tend to be looked at separately, diet and exercise are actually interconnected.

According to the American College of Sports Medicine, adequate food and fluid should be consumed before, during and after exercise. Following that advice can help men and women maintain their blood glucose concentration during exercise, which allows them to maximize their performance and improves their recovery time.

Some people understandably may feel that eating before exercising seems counterintuitive, as food may contribute to feelings of sluggishness that would make it hard to maximize a workout. But what people eat, and drink, prior to working out is important, as the right foods can make a positive impact while the wrong foods can have the oppo-

The American Heart Association and the ACSM recommend hydrating with water prior to working out. The ACSM recommends drinking between two and three cups of water two to three hours before exercising. Adults accustomed to working out in the early morning can try to wake up earlier so they can give their bodies time to hydrate before they begin exercising. It's also important to continue hydrating during a workout, as the ACSM recommends drinking between 1/2 and one cup of water every 15 to 20 minutes during a workout (amounts can be adjusted based on variables such as the weather and individuals' body sizes). After a workout, the ACSM recommends drinking two to three cups of water for every pound lost during the exercise session.

Food also plays a vital role in maximizing a workout and improving recovery time. The AHA rec-Page 7 - HMS

Diet and exercise are each vital components of a ommends fueling up on healthy carbohydrates, such as whole-grain cereals, whole-wheat toast or low-fat or fat-free yogurt, two hours before exercising. Doing so might pose a problem for early morning exercise enthusiasts, and in such instances the AHA advises eating a piece of fruit such as an apple or banana five to 10 minutes before beginning a workout. Avoid saturated fats and a lot of healthy protein prior to working out, as it takes longer for these fuels to digest in the stomach. Until foods are digested, muscles may not get all of the oxygen and energy-delivering blood they need during a workout, so it's best to stick with foods that the body can digest more quickly. The Mayo Clinic notes that it's also important to make food a part of your post-workout routine. Eating a post-workout meal that contains both carbohydrates and protein can aid muscle recovery and replace glycogen stores that help increase energy levels after working out.

The most effective way to exercise involves healthy foods, which can improve performance and lead to quicker post-workout recovery.





Conditions That Fall Under The Umbrella of COPD

Despite its prevalence, COPD might not be on a person's radar until they or someone they love is diagnosed with this disease of the lungs. But understanding COPD, which is an umbrella term that describes various progressive lung diseases, can help people lower their risk and potentially identify symptoms and seek treatment.
WHAT IS COPD?

The COPD Foundation notes that COPD is characterized by increasing breathlessness. The disease is currently incurable. However, treatment can help people effectively manage their COPD and breathe better. In fact, many people with COPD live for many years and continue to enjoy

life after diagnosis.
WHAT CONDITIONS FALL UNDER THE UMBRELLA OF COPD? Emphysema, chronic bronchitis and refractory (non-reverse) asthma are three conditions that fall under the umbrella of

• Emphysema: Damage to the alveoli, which are tiny air sacs in the lungs, causes emphysema. When this damage occurs, the walls inside the alveoli disappear, turning the small sacs into large sacs. The resulting larger sacs cannot absorb oxygen as effectively as the small sacs, so less oxygen is then absorbed into the blood. In addition, the lungs become stretched out and lose their springiness when the alveoli are damaged. The airways become flabby, trapping air in the lungs and creating feelings of shortness of breath.

• CHRONIC BRONCHITIS: Chronic bronchitis is caused when the bronchial tubes are irritated and become swollen. That damage causes coughing and shortness of breath. Bronchitis becomes chronic bronchitis when mucus comes up with the cough and the cough lasts for at least three months for two years in a row. The COPD Foundation also notes that, in healthy lungs, tiny hairs known as cilia help move mucus up the tubes of the lungs so it can be coughed out. When a person has chronic bronchitis, the tubes have lost their cilia, leading to more coughing and irritating the lungs even further and creating more mucus. 




